



## Code of Ethics

Inland Northwest Land Conservancy's integrity and reputation as a land conservancy are of utmost importance. Organization employees and others who work on the organizations behalf must act at all times in a manner that not only respects the spirit of applicable laws and regulations, but also preserves INLC's reputation. Some of the standards of conduct expected of INLC employees are set out in the Employee Handbook, but these conduct standards are not intended to be all-inclusive. Generally speaking, it is the responsibility of each INLC employee to conduct himself or herself in a manner consistent with the organization's best interests and in a manner that will contribute to the success of INLC and its employees.
